

## 2022 LSHR Plant Releases

- 1. *Callicarpa americana* 'Alba' LAMIACEAE** (White Berry Beautyberry) – Deciduous native woody shrub with arching growth pattern reaching 6' x 6'. Produces white flowers in spring followed by showy, white berries in the fall. Prefers full sun. Attracts pollinators. Propagated by cuttings and seed.
- 2. *Callicarpa salicifolia* LAMIACEAE** (Willowleaf Beautyberry) – Deciduous shrub with a loose, delicate growth habit and shiny, green foliage. Produces light purplish-pink flowers from late spring to fall and lavender berries in late fall. Grows to 8' x 4'. Prune in late winter to create a bushy appearance. Propagated by cuttings and seed.
- 3. *Hydrangea paniculata* HYDRANGEACEAE** (Baby Lace Hydrangea) – Dwarf paniculata form Hydrangea that produces petite, lacy-white flower clusters against dark foliage. Deciduous shrub that grows to 4' x 4'. Prefers shade to partial shade and best grown in morning sun and afternoon shade. Perfect for containers and small gardens. Great cut flower and dries well for use in arrangements. Developed by Dr. Michael Dirr, horticulture professor emeritus, University of Georgia and included in the Gardener's Confidence Collection. (PP#23387).
- 4. *Leucothoe axillaris* ERICACEAE** (Coastal Doghobble) – Native evergreen shrub with dark green glossy foliage that tends to turn reddish in the winter. Produces white, bell-shaped flowers in small racemes from the leaf axis. A multi-selection having good form and disease resistance. Prefers full sun and well-drained, acidic, humus-rich soil. Grows to 4' x 4'. Propagated by cuttings.
- 5. *Podocarpus macrophyllus* 'Miu' PODOCARPACEAE** (Roman Candle Podocarpus) – Evergreen coniferous shrub that produces variegated new foliage that is white to light green. Tough, low maintenance, upright shrub that is resistant to disease, pests and deer. Grow in full sun for best foliage color. Use as a hedge or accent plant. Grows to 10-15' x 3-4'. (PP#28582)
- 6. *Tecoma stans* 'Gold Star' BIGNONIACEAE** (Gold Star Esperanza) – Fast-growing, heat-loving, flowering shrub that produces large clusters of bell-shaped, bright-yellow flowers. Most floriferous of all the Esperanzas. Blooms at an early age and continues blooming until frost. Great for containers. Grow in full sun. Attracts pollinators. A Greg Grant selection. Grows to 6'. Propagated by cuttings.
